Guaymas, Sonora, Mexico, was selected as Mesa's first Sister City in 1981. Guaymas is located 250 miles south of the U.S. border on the Gulf of California. Upper Hutt, New Zealand, was added as our second Sister City in 1983. This beautiful area outside of Wellington, is also home to the Tempe Sister City, Lower Hutt. Caraz, Peru, became Mesa's third Sister City in 1989. The Cordillera Blanca, the highest range of mountains in the tropical world, surrounds the village of Caraz. Kaiping, China, became Mesa's fourth Sister City in 1993. Kaiping is an industrial city with a mixture of ancient traditions and modern society.



Burnaby, British Columbia, Canada, is near Vancouver and became Mesa's newest sister City in 1999. Like Mesa, Burnaby is part of a large metropolitan area, but still maintains its own identity.

Mesa Sister Cities Achievements:

- Delivered over \$250,000 worth of medical supplies, including 280 wheelchairs, 6 ambulances and 2 fire trucks to Caraz, Peru and Guaymas, Mexico.
- Provided medical assistance to over 12,000 rural Peruvians including over 2,500 surgeries
- 2009 International Program Award Winner
- Increased multicultural awareness through expanded 2015 / 2016 student exchange programs
